#### The Firehouse Update By Danny Estrella

In compliance with California state directives, the Firehouse is closed for rentals during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Firehouse playground is also closed. We know that this is a hardship for some families with children and extend our apologies. But this will help us to comply with the guidelines for physical distancing during the pandemic.



We've received bids from Peninsula Siding Company on the cost to have the Firehouse re-siding work done. We have two bids, one for re-siding with Hardie siding (\$80,000) and one for re-siding with LP siding (\$88,940). There may be additional expenses if there is any structural damage found as the siding work is underway. As we don't have enough funds to pay for either of these two amounts, we'll need to seek other funding sources to bridge the gap between available PPCA funds and the amount of the bid. I've reached out to Hardie and LP for discounts on materials and am awaiting their response. One thought is to take out a home equity loan using the Firehouse as collateral. We are holding off until the COVID-19 pandemic is over and we can count on rental revenue to pay such a loan.

We still need to replace some tables and chairs. Please consider making a donation to the tables and chairs replacement fund. A \$90 donation will buy a 4-pack of comfortable folding chairs. A \$370 donation will buy a 4-pack of tables. Any donation amount will be gratefully accepted and go towards the purchase of tables and chairs.



Hoping we'll be back to normal activities by September so save the weekend date for Fogfest 2020: Sept 26 and 27!

#### Seating of new 2020 PPCA Board and Selection of Officers

#### **Headlands Trail Discussion**

Hilary Walecka from Coastal Conservancy and Ryan Maquez (City of Pacifica) came to discuss the Pedro Point Coastal Trail Project. The current design is to connect the trail along Linda Mar State Beach to the Devil's Slide Trail and the Pedro Point Headlands via a path along San Pedro Avenue parallel to Highway 1.

#### **Treasurer's Report**

The treasurer's report of the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenses through Dec. 31, 2019 was submitted and approved.

#### **Events Committee Report**

The Dinner on the Point is scheduled for Sat. March 14, 2020 (cancelled and will be rescheduled due to the Covid-19 pandemic).

#### **Firehouse Maintenance Report**

Siding: The Firehouse siding has become severely degraded. Three sides of the Firehouse need to be ripped out and replaced. Danny is seeking bids from Peninsula Siding. There are two options:

Rip out and replace siding or put on new siding atop the old siding without seeing what is underneath

Some opportunities for saving money: Danny may be able to get a discount if a crew offers to help. Potential Work Party? Any neighbors have skills? Please contact Danny at <u>warnella@hotmail.com</u> if you can help.

Downstairs Party Room, adjacent to the playground—any interest in converting that into a cheaper/secondary party rental location? Yes, but without bathroom access, it probably wouldn't be feasible.

Julian will be repairing the plastic tables which have failed in the past.

On Thursday, January 2, the PPCA sent formal comments **opposing** the City of Pacifica's proposed change in the Pedro Point (Calson-owned) Field from Visitor-Serving Commercial-Recreational uses to a Coastal Residential Mixed Use. **New Business**—None **Adjournment**
